(January 12, 2023) – Nemours Children's Health has announced the recruitment of Thomas Babcock, MD, as a neurotologist specializing in disorders related to the ear including procedures for hearing loss such as cochlear implantation, to our Otolaryngology Division in Pensacola. He joins Nemours Children's from Baptist Medical Group in Pensacola. Dr. Babcock is currently seeing patients at Nemours Children's Health's Pensacola clinic located at 8331 North Davis Highway.
