"This role will be transformative for the benefit of Nemours and our patient families."

"While building the long-term data and AI strategy, my initial goal is to improve process efficiency and ensure consistent reporting. My primary focus is toward generating valuable business intelligence and insights that will ultimately improve the value and quality of service we provide patient families," Balaji said.
