(April 16, 2026) – Leaders, clinicians and associates from Nemours Children's Health were joined today by local residents, elected officials and healthcare advocates as they broke ground on Nemours Children's Health, Viera, a new 34,000 square-foot multi-specialty care facility in Melbourne.

Nemours Children's Health, Viera, will be located in the medical plaza off Stadium Parkway between Napolo Drive and N. Wickham Road in Melbourne.
