In 2019, he joined the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health, serving as Chief of Pediatric Urology and Director of Global Urology, and as Professor in the Departments of Urology, Surgery, and Pediatrics.

He is board certified in urology with subspecialty certification in pediatric urology, a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American College of Surgeons and has held a Master of Laws (LL.M.) degree as well as numerous national leadership roles, including Society of Pediatric Urology (SPU) and President-Elect of the American Association of Pediatric Urologists (AAPU). He has served as course chair and faculty for pediatric urology laparoscopy course (PULC) and training programs, helping train fellows and surgeons across North America and globally.
