Winter Garden resident, Jeanette Brown attended the ceremony with her three children. Her daughter, 7-yearold Bella, marked the official opening of the facility by using giant red scissors to cut the ceremonial Nemours Band-Aid ribbon.

Bella was born with a complex heart condition and has been a Nemours patient most of her life. Browns' two sons are also patients and she often travels to Nemours Children's Hospital in Lake Nona when they need care. Now, some of those specialists will be seeing patients at the new facility. This saves Brown travel time but more importantly, she says, it gives her peace of mind.

The 12,000-square-foot medical facility offers families a range of specialty services such as:

In addition to these specialties, the new location includes a Nemours Children's Primary Care practice. Board-certified pediatrician Rhonda Elton, MD, FAAP, will provide routine well- and sick-child care, immunizations and treatment of everyday bumps and bruises for children from newborn to age 18. Dr. Elton has been caring for children since 1993. Before moving to Central Florida, she provided expert care in her home state of Michigan. She is a fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics.

Nemours operates a full-service, 100 bed children's hospital with an Emergency Department in Lake Nona. Nemours also has 12 specialty care locations, 17 primary care and four urgent care locations throughout central Florida.
