The 90-minute discussion featured Nemours Dr. Floyd Livingston, Division Chief of Pediatric Pulmonary & Sleep Medicine; Dr. Gift Kopsombut, faculty member with the Division of Hospital Medicine; and Dr. Lonna Gordon, Associate Chief for Adolescent Medicine, who shared the latest information about how e-cigarrettes are marketed to teens, what their chemical composition is, and the damage that vaping does to the body.
