

# Nemours Children's Primary Care Selected for National Multi-Site Learning Community for Accelerating Child Health Care Transformation



Orlando, Fla. – (June 2, 2021) Nemours Children's Primary Care, Central Florida, has been selected to join a national effort to identify strategies that will lead to a transformation of health care for our nation's children. Nemours will join a cadre of 11 national leading child health care providers and participate in *Accelerating Child Health Transformations*. This multi-site learning community will assist pediatric practices in finding ways to address inequities and improve healthcare for children. It is made possible with support from the

Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and led by the Center for Health Care Strategies (CHCS).

Over the next nine months, Nemours and the other 11 learning community participants will collaborate to identify strategies to support child healthcare transformation. The main goals of this initiative are to adopt anti-racist practices to advance health equity, create equitable partnerships with families and providers, and identify family strengths and health-related social needs to promote resilience.
